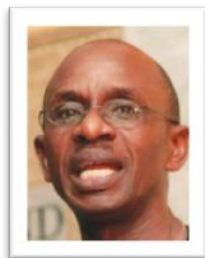
KEMI OLUTUNBI (CHARTERED FCIPD)

VICTOR A. BANJO, MNI, CHARTERED FCIPD, M.IOD

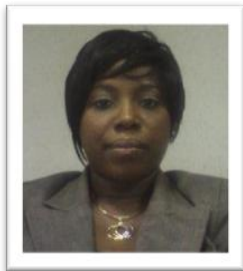
